Last Shelter: Survival can be just a game about a postapocalyptic world that has decayed through a zombie virus. The good part - it's high in icky, gross dreadful stuff that produces horror novels interesting, the not too good part - that I wasn't crazy about it. The personality development was shallow and maybe if the six children who have stuck at the bad part of the town in the nighttime weren't so stupid and lame, I would have liked the book longer.

Often derided as the worst book ever to get a HugoThey'd rather Be Right is a choice example of the disposable pulp fiction which flourished during sci fi 's "Golden Age." The book 's central character, Joe, is actually a benevolent version of The Mule from Asimov's Foundation and Empire, probably the clearest regurgitation in a work characterized by its own inclination to retread notions that even afterward were thoroughly explored.
